

## ***Funded –***

Since our first event in 2010, over **\$647,169(net)** has been raised through 100 Men Who Cook, 100 Men Who Golf, and Just Desserts! to provide funds to various organizations to address the needs of the most vulnerable in our community.

### **Examples of our funding:**

#### ***A Better Way Services:***

Over \$225,000 to provide security and treatment to victims of domestic violence.

#### ***Second Harvest Food Bank/ Teamwork for Quality Living:***

Over \$200,000 to provide Help for today and Hope for Tomorrow by providing resources to fulfill the needs of food insecure families and individuals as well as a relationship based Poverty Elimination Program.

#### ***Boys & Girls Club of Muncie:***

Provide funding to provide a safe and secure environment for programming that empowers youth to achieve academic success, live healthy lifestyles.

#### ***The Unity Center:***

Programming to increase awareness of community gun violence and to empower youth to their ability to oppose the use of guns.

#### ***The Muncie Action Plan:***

“Facing Racism” that explored the impacts of racism and the meaning of race in people’s lives. Exposing the harmful nature of structural or institutional racism, and reveal the way in which our community can triumph over ignorance.

#### ***BY5 Early Childhood Education:***

Strengthening Families Program to provide family skills training aimed at improving parenting and family functioning.
